School Lunches – Reception to Year 6 Pupils

You are now able to order your child's/children's school dinner up to three weeks in advance on the School Gateway App. Parents are unable to order for their child on the App on the day. If it is a whole school trip then the only option available to you on that day will be packed lunches. If, however, it is just a year group then packed lunch will have to be ordered by notifying school by text or email. If your child is going to be late in, please ensure

that you let us know before 9.30am. If you have pre-ordered and your child is absent from school, we will remove the dinner for that day.

A polite reminder that children must be in school for 8.55am prompt.

If your child is unable to attend school due to illness, make sure the school office is informed at the earliest opportunity. Children do suffer from coughs and colds, however unless they are running a temperature they can still come into school. There is guidance on the NHS website if you are unsure. Children need to remain at home for 48 hours after the last episode of a tummy bug!
